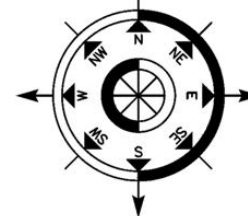

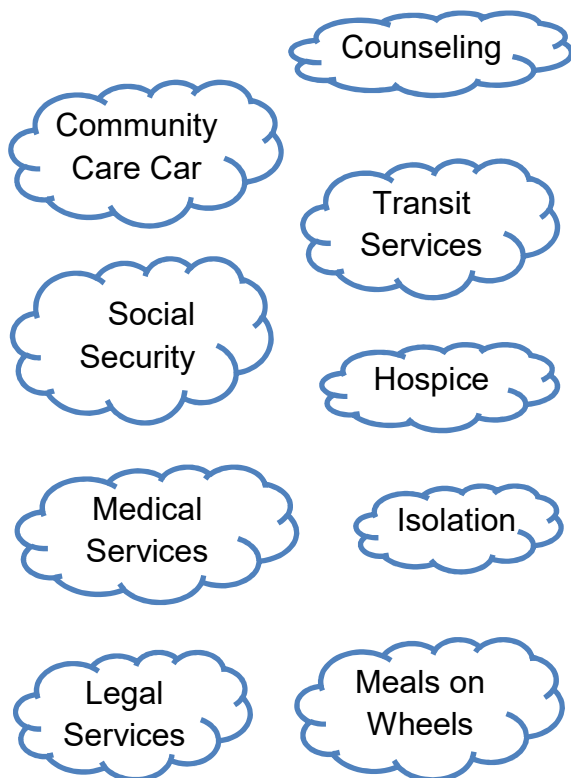

# How We Do It

Many people do not know where to turn when a crisis or problems rears its head in their lives. Additionally, knowing about a potential resource does not mean that someone will actually access those services. There are many reasons this occurs and our goals are to erase those barriers.



To do this, we reach out to existing programs and forge relationships with them. We believe that it is not enough to know about programs, we need to establish communication channels to assist our clients in accessing their services.
